

Any restrictions associated with any of the products will be either marked as "No restrictions" or "Do not..." with a date that those activities can be resumed.

Note: Different products have different Water-Use Restrictions. Thus, the longest restriction per category of each product will be entered.

Example: The Swimming and Bathing restriction has been marked as "Do not swim or bathe or enter area until: 6/18/20." This means you cannot swim, bathe, or enter the treated area until the date is 6/18/20.
